2026-012765-HDRB. 1062 Camino San Acacio, Downtown & Eastside Historic District, contributing, The HDRB will decide whether reconsideration of the August 25, 2026, approval is in order under Robert's Rules of Order. The approval was for construction of a 733 sq. ft. guesthouse with a height of 14'-4" where the maximum allowable height is 16'-4", and to construct a yard wall to the maximum allowable height of 4'-0" and a trellis to a height of 9'-0". Discussion of and Possible Reconsideration:

2026-012764-HDRB. 1062 Camino San Acacio, Downtown & Eastside Historic District, contributing, The HDRB will decide whether reconsideration of the August 25, 2026, approval is in order under Robert's Rules of Order. The approval was for construction of a 3,440 sq. ft. residence to a height of 20'-3" on a sloped site, where the maximum allowable is 16'-4" and up to 4'-0" of additional height may be permitted at the board's discretion: 6'-0" high fencing. The board found that the criteria had been met and an exception was granted to 14-4.6(E)(4)(II) for use of steel portal elements and other exterior details. (Lani McCulley)
